*Students with a 1360-1600 will be awarded a laptop, and students with a 1450-1600 will be awarded a laptop and a study abroad stipend (up to \$4500) sponsored by the President's Top Hawks Fund.

**Students must live on campus to be eligible for the housing award. Housing awards will not roll over into a refund. It will only be used to cover residence hall and meal plan costs.

***Out-of-State Warhawk Scholarships are available to students who qualify.
